## Your Reassurance Lies in the Covenant

By now, you've probably studied the Contract of Sale and if so, you will have noticed a section entitled "Community Development Standards Covenant.

The word "Covenant" means a promise or an undertaking. In this case, the QM Properties' Building Covenant outlines those standards of building which are acceptable in our communities, as well those which are not. The Covenant is an integral part of your contract, and vital to the protection of your property values, so please make sure that it is completed in full.

It is in your own best interest to study your Covenant and understand it thoroughly. We will be more than happy to help you in this regard.

You need to provide your builder with a copy of the Covenant and clear advice that you have a legal obligation to comply with the conditions of the Covenant. Your builder needs to be aware that you must submit copies of all plans and specifications to QM Properties for approval, prior to any plans going to council.

Assuming plans meet with our Community Development Standard (Covenant), QM approval will be effected speedily and easily.

An important point to remember is that the Covenant transfers from owner to owner. You are therefore obliged to include the Covenant as part of your contract of sale should you later sell your property.
